<p><b>3. Responsibility</b> SC 803</p>	<p>The Superintendent, after consultation with the building principal shall be responsible for the selection and recommendation of all resource materials. <p><b>4. Standards for Approval</b></p>	<p>The Superintendent shall develop guidelines for the selection of resource materials.</p> <p>In considering the approval of any proposed instructional and evaluative material, the board should judge its suitability for the maturity level and educational content for the students who will be using the materials; freedom from bias; relationship to the curriculum; relationship to a continuous multigrade, articulated program; impact on community standards of taste; manner of selection; cost; and appearance and durability.
