**DETERMINATION OF RESIDENT STATUS OF STUDENTS OF THE
CATASAUQUA AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT**

A student attending any school district sponsored college shall be classified as a
Catasauqua Area School District resident for tuition purposes if he or she has a
Catasauqua Area School District domicile.

DETERMINATION OF CATASAUQUA AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT

DOMICILE

Domicile is the place where one intends to and does in fact permanently reside.

- a. Continuous residence in the Catasauqua Area School District for a period
of twelve (12) months prior to initial registration as a sponsored student
creates a presumption of domicile. One is presumed not to be domiciliary
if one has resided for a shorter period before attending a school district
sponsored college.
- b. The name of the resident must be on the Per Capita rolls of the Catasauqua
Area School District and/or the property tax rolls.
- c. A married woman is presumed to have the domicile of her husband.

d. A minor is presumed to have the domicile of his/her parent(s) or guardian.

The age of majority in the Catasauqua Area School District for establishing a domicile for tuition purposes is twenty-one. It is the minor's responsibilities to prove his/her emancipation.

e. A member of the United States Armed Forces, who was domiciled in the Catasauqua Area School District immediately preceding entry in to the Armed Forces and who has continuously maintained the Catasauqua Area School District as his/her legal residence will be presumed to have a Catasauqua Area School District domicile.
