<p>204</p> <p>State School Code – Section 1362</p>	<p><u>204 - POLICY RE SCHOOL BUSING</u></p> <p>Beginning September 1, 1979, the following school bus policy will become effective for both public and private school students using public school buses.</p> <p>The Catasauqua Area School District will transport Sheckler school students that live further than three-fourths of a mile from the school building, Lincoln Middle School students that live further than one and a half miles from the school building and Catasauqua High School students that live further than 1.5 miles from the school building. Mileage will be computed by the shortest non-hazardous route. Handicapped students, that are certified as handicapped students by the proper authorities, will be transported on an individual basis. Students that are required to travel a hazardous route to school will be transported. Students that are able to detour around a hazardous area and still arrive at their school under the mileage requirement will not be transported.
